Responsibilities:

Under the authority and supervision of the Director of UNW-DPC and the supervision of the responsible Programme Officer, the successful candidate will be entrusted with the following tasks:

- Coordinate and develop the UNW-DPC Learning Management System (LMS);
- Develop the necessary learning contents and multimedia materials for the LMS;
- Record, edit and produce professional documentary videos;
- Support the IT team in operating and further developing the UNW Activity Information System (UNW-AIS);
- Perform other tasks as assigned by the Director or Programme Officer as needed.

Required Qualifications and Competencies:

- Minimum Bachelors degree (or equivalent) in Informatics, Computer Science or a related field;
- At least two (2) years of work experience;
- Experience in recording professional videos and preparing documentary video materials;
- Strong natural graphic and multimedia design sensibilities layout, style, color, typography, etc;
- Ability to effectively use video editing software;
- Working experience with Learning Management Systems (LMS), mainly Moodle, as well as other tools and design techniques;
- Good understanding and experience of Structured Query Language (SQL) databases would be an advantage;
- Excellent command of oral and written English is essential;
- Good team player with strong interpersonal skills demonstrated by the ability to work in a multi-cultural, multi-ethnic environment;
- Highly self-motivated and self-organised and be able to trouble-shoot;
- Ability to display good attention to detail and maintain professional and responsible work attitude.

Remuneration:

Remuneration will commensurate with qualification and years of experience.

The terms and conditions of employment shall be governed by the Personnel Services Agreement (PSA) category contract.

Duration of Contract:

The successful candidate will be based at UNW-DPC in Bonn on a full-time basis under the Personnel Service Agreement (PSA) category for an initial period of one year (12 months) with a possibility of extension.
